#### The members raised the following issues:

- Should look at development of area surrounding Cross River as an amenity
- Lack of direct access to green belt area could lead to anti-social behaviour
- Number of concerns with road junctions in the area
- Traffic survey should be conducted to plan for future development
- Wastewater Treatment Plant currently close to its capacity clarification needs to be sought on future proposals
- Important that land is developed in a sustainable manner
- Vacant properties should be utilised public need to be made aware of the Rate Incentive Scheme
- Concern that recreational area is too close to main road query the standard size of a green/recreational area
- Lands identified as educational on northern portion of map be reclassified as recreational to provide additional facilities
- Issue with anti-social behaviour at community facilities at Roscommon County Council Offices in Monksland
- Lack of potential lands indentified for burial grounds
- Issue with lack of accessible walking and cycling routes around schools

Mr. Martin Lydon, A/Director of Services responded to queries raised as follows:

- There are no development levies associated with change of use to a vacant property
- No set guidelines to determine the size of a park or green area
- As per the land use zoning matrix, burial grounds are 'acceptable in principle' or 'open to consideration' in a number of land use zonings

Mr. Alan O'Connell, A/Senior Executive Planner responded to the issues raised as follows:

- Capacity of the wastewater treatment plant relates to hydrological loading rather than biological loading.
- Irish Water to carry out some minor upgrade works to bio-tower

It was **AGREED** to the correct a textual error on page 27 of the plan and amend the number of households from 6,200 to 2,480, and to correctly refer to the Core Strategy instead of Housing Strategy for County Roscommon.
