It was **AGREED** that Section 11 (2) (b) of the Roads Act 1993 and Roads Regulations 1994, Part 2 Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), Section 180 Local Government Reform Act 2014 Schedule 3 Declaration of public road within the housing development at **River Oaks, Ballinagare** be **ADOPTED**.

Members made the following comments:

Roscommon Co. Council, the Planning Section and the MD Office were thanked by Members for their work in getting these estates taken in charge.

Boyle MD has 58 unfinished estates, the highest in the Co. and concerns were raised that the Council is left with the consequence of the property crash and the cost of taking these estates in charge.

On the **PROPOSAL** of Councillor Sean Moylan
SECONDED by Councillor Michéal Frain

It was **AGREED** that at the Budget Meeting for 2027 members would request that the budget allocation for Taking in Charge would be pro rata across the 3 MDs based on the number of estates in the MD.

Councillor Sean Moylan added that at the next MD meeting, a letter would be drafted to the local members of the Oireachtas requesting additional funding from Central Government for taking estates in charge.

Councillor Michéal Frain stated the ERDF money was returned to the EU as unspent. He stated that the Local Authority should look at other funding streams that would be available.

Mr. Sean Mullarkey stated that €150,000 was allocated as additional funding towards costs of taking in charge. This would cover the taking in charge of smaller estates, however, up to €500,000 would be needed for the larger estates. He will provide a detailed list of the costs associated with TIC of estates.

9.25 CIVIC RECEPTION 2026 NOMINATIONS

On the **PROPOSAL** of Councillor Sean Moylan

SECONDED by Councillor Valerie Byrne

And **AGREED** that John McDermott (Octogenarian), Boyle be nominated for the Civic Reception 2026 following his gold medal win in the Decathlon at the European Masters M80 championships in Maderia at end of last year.

10.25 AOB

Members raised the following issues:

- How are roads classified for inclusion in the winter maintenance/gritting schedule. Councillors are being asked by members of the public for church yards and school yards to be done. Roads like Cotehall Road with heavy traffic and link to N4 should be included.

On the **PROPOSAL** of Cllr. Leah Cull,

SECONDED by Cllr. Micheál Frain

And **AGREED** that a Grit bin/salt bin scheme be looked into for Roscommon County similar to scheme being run by Monaghan Co. Council.

- Should be an item for SPC meeting.
- Cllr Liam Callaghan stated that this is an issue for the Plenary meeting. Budgetary implications, staff limits, etc. all impact on gritting programme.
- New surface on N61 slippery –
- Realignment of roads like Cotehall would relieve these problems
- Insurance issue with grit bins – i.e. if a path is gritted today and not tomorrow there is a liability there and this could be an issue for members of the public who avail of the gritting bins for gritting roads and footpaths themselves.
- 2 major issues for Councillors every year – road gritting and potholes. Can alternative solutions be looked at. If it's possible for Monaghan Co. Council, it should be possible for Roscommon.

Mr. Ivor Kilcline clarified that gritting is a county-wide issue. DOT fund gritting of regional roads, TII fund national and secondary roads in the region. If local roads were to be added, costs would have to be covered from RCC's own resources. Currently 8 trucks grit across the county on 3-hour call outs.

Routes will be updated when N5 by-pass is completed, and roads will be reclassified.

- Farming Rathcroghan: members raised concerns about the future of Farming Rathcroghan due to funding concerns. Project was unsuccessful in its bid to secure EU Funding for the coming year and therefore project could only continue until March this year. The issue is that loss of funding means that the project office and its five staff members will cease to operate. Members asked that funding could be made available that would allow the office to continue its operations until such time as an

alternative funding stream was found for the project.

On the **PROPOSAL** of Cllr. Liam Callaghan

SECONDED by Cllr. Sean Moylan

And **AGREED** that Roscommon Co. Council would investigate alternative funding to keep the Farming Rathcroghan Office in operation until funding streams can be found.

Mr. Sean Mullarkey, stated that Farming Rathcroghan is an external organisation however, he was confident that it would be looked at favourably by main stakeholders.

Cllr. Callaghan informed members that TII are to attend the Plenary meeting in March and asked if roads could be added to the list, e.g. R370 as this road has a solid white line.

Mr. Ivor Kilcline stated that realignments are carried out under the Department of Transport, upkeep and maintenance of regional roads by Department of Transport and RCC. No additional funding available for such works currently.

Cllr. Sean Moylan asked about Roads Programme and when it's finalised.

Mr. Ivor Kilcline stated that the Roads Programme 2026 is as per that agreed informally by members at the December meeting and will be formally approved at the Boyle MD meeting in March. 90% of the funding requested will be allocated by DoT. Should members of the public enquire about a particular road on the ReportIt system, they will be informed if the particular road is on the list.

The next meeting will be on Friday, 20th March, 2026.

1.0 Introduction

Section 58 of the Local Government Reform Act 2014 inserts a new section 103A of the Local Government Act 2001 stating that, following the adoption of the annual budget, a schedule of proposed works of maintenance and repair to be carried out during the financial year in each Municipal District shall be prepared, for adoption by the Municipal District Members.

The Schedule of Municipal District Works (SMDW) in respect of the Municipal District is formulated on the basis of the amount of funding provided for maintenance and repair in the annual budget in respect of the relevant service division. The plan of works outlined in the SMDW prioritises and apportions the use, within the Municipal District, of the funding provided in the overall revenue budget for particular purposes. Key objectives in preparing the SMDW are maximising value for money, overall effectiveness and return from investment.

It should be noted that it may be necessary to reallocate funding during the year to deal with emergencies arising or when scheduled works cannot proceed for some reason. Any such reallocation will be notified to members as part of the monthly Management Report. A summary of the SMDW is included in Appendix 1.

2.0 Repair & Maintenance Operations

The schedule of municipal district works covers administration, construction, maintenance and repair operations in the following service divisions:

Division A	Housing
Division B	Roads
Division D	Development Management
Division E	Environmental Services
Division F	Recreation & Amenity
Division G	Agriculture, Education, Health and Welfare

2.1 Housing

Boyle Municipal District no longer carries out non-routine maintenance of Local Authority housing stock. This function is now part of a procurement framework that is managed by the Housing Department. We continue to maintain grass in some areas where the council tenants are unable to maintain the open spaces. The municipal district also provides an emergency an out-of-hour service for housing tenants in the area.

2.2 Roads

Boyle Municipal District Road Works Scheme 2026 provides a detailed breakdown of the works which shall be provided by the Boyle Municipal District this year. The type of works included is:

- National Primary and Secondary Roads - General Maintenance
- Regional Roads – General Maintenance, Improvement Works and Surface Dressing
- Local Roads – General Maintenance, Improvement Works and Surface Dressing
- Winter Maintenance Programme.
- Drainage Works
- Flooding and Severe Weather response
- Public Lighting
- Footpath provision and repairs
- Bridge repairs and rehabilitation
- Community Involvement Schemes
- Low-cost safety Improvement works
- Local Involvement Schemes

The adoption of the Boyle Schedule of Municipal District Works 2026 will include the approval of the **Boyle Municipal District Road Works Scheme 2026**.

2.4 Development Management

The Boyle Municipal District administers the allocation of Municipal District funding under this annual scheme. The scheme is advertised, and public are invited to submit applications. Following receipt of application projects are allocated funding as directed by the members

2.5 Environmental

Services Maintenance of

Burial Grounds

There are 35 Burial Grounds in the Boyle Municipal District. An allocation of €36,700 is available to operate and maintain burial grounds in the District. An additional grant of €7,500 is available for emergency repairs.

A Burial Grounds Major Repair Works grant of €25,000 has been provided for 2026.

Recycling

The Council operates 12 bring banks throughout the District. These are operated under contract by the Environmental Section and cleaning and litter removal is carried out by MD staff. There are two Civic Amenity Sites located within the Boyle MD.

2.6 Recreation and Amenity

Boyle MD maintains road verges and open spaces in the towns of Boyle, Ballaghaderreen and Strokestown as well as a number of other recreation areas, through a combination of direct labour and contract services.

In 2026, a budget of €180,000 is available to carry out additional works in and around the public spaces in the Boyle MD. It is proposed that this budget is spent as outlined below.
