- River Oaks, Ballinagare


In accordance with Section 11 (2) (b) Roscommon County Council has:

The final date for submissions in relation to the declaration was 4pm on 21 November 2025. No objection or representation was received.

The declaration of a roads to be a public road is a reserved function to be performed by Municipal District Members. The Council will be charged with the future maintenance of the roads. Drawings are attached showing the roads to be taken in charge.
